

FRUIT IN YOUR SEASON

Psalm 1:1-3 (KJV)

1 *Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.*

2 *But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.*

3 *And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.*

Psalm 1:1-3 (Message)

1 *How well God must like you— you don't hang out at Sin Saloon, you don't slink along Dead-End Road, you don't go to Smart-Mouth College.*

2-3 *Instead you thrill to God's Word, you chew on Scripture day and night. You're a tree replanted in Eden, bearing fresh fruit every month, Never dropping a leaf, always in blossom.*

Psalm 1:1-3 (AMP)

1 *BLESSED (HAPPY, fortunate, prosperous, and enviable) is the man who walks and lives not in the counsel of the ungodly [following their advice, their plans and purposes], nor stands [submissive and inactive] in the path where sinners walk, nor sits down [to relax and rest] where the scornful [and the mockers] gather.*

2 *But his delight and desire are in the law of the Lord, and on His law (the precepts, the instructions, the teachings of God) he habitually meditates (ponders and studies) by day and by night.*

3 *And he shall be like a tree firmly planted [and tended] by the streams of water, ready to bring forth its fruit in its season; its leaf also shall not fade or wither; and everything he does shall prosper [and come to maturity].*

- It is very important where you walk, stand, and sit.
- Psalm 1:1** clearly tells us to watch where we allow ourselves to go or what we allow ourselves to participate in.
- Psalm 1:2** clearly tells us to live a lifestyle of meditation in the Word of God.
- Psalm 1:3** clearly tells us that if we obey verse 1&2 that we will yield fruit in our season.
- There is a due season for your life.
- What harvests during that season is up to you.

IDENTIFY THE PROBLEM

Ephesians 6:12

- Most Christians have an excuse for why they are in the current situation that they are in.
- Our problem is not with the economy, our boss, our spouse, our parents, our financial situation, or whatever else you can think of.
- Our problem is with the opposing team (Satan).

Ephesians 6:13-17

- We are in a fight with another world.
- When you are getting ready for a fight there are certain things that you have to do in order to prepare.
- Your technique has to be right.
- Your apparel has to be right.
- Your stance has to be right.

IDENTIFY THE SOLUTION

Ephesians 1:17-23

- We are not fighting **for** victory.
- We are fighting **from** victory.
- God has already given you the power to withstand and to conquer every attack from the devil.
- Romans 4:17** says, "...call those things that are not as though they were."

FAITH THAT OVERCOMES

-Faith is the only thing that will bring you out of what looks like defeat, and will bring you into victory.

-Take your stance now.

-Don't wait until the battle comes to begin to prepare.
