

POWER TO REVEAL

Romans 1:16-17 (KJV)

16 *For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.*

17 *For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.*

-There is power that comes from the Word of God.

-Romans 10:17 (KJV) says:

17 *So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.*

-Faith is revealed in the Word of God.

-Faith is created from the Word of God.

-Every Christian that lives a lifestyle of reading and listening to God's Word will enter into new levels of faith.

-God did not create you to stay at entry-level faith.

-At each level of faith there is a new revelation.

IDENTIFY YOUR MOUNTAIN

Mark 11:22-24 (KJV)

22 *And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.*

23 *For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.*

24 *Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.*

Steps to removing a mountain:

1. The first thing that Jesus tells us to do is to have the God kind of faith.

2. Before you can begin to remove mountains you have to understand that you qualify for the task at hand.

-You are a whosoever.

3. The next thing that He tells us to do is to identify the mountain.

4. The next thing that He tells us to do is to speak to the identified mountain.
5. The next thing that Jesus says is what we should be saying to the identified mountain.
6. The last thing He tells us is to get our heart and mind in line with our words.

STUCK IN THE MUD

- Have you ever been stuck in the mud?
- What's the first thing you do?
 - Keep spinning your tires?
 - Keep putting the car in reverse and then back to drive a few times?
 - Step out and try to push by yourself?
- Most times when we are stuck in the mud we need someone else or a tool of some kind to pull us out.
- Too many times we live our lives stuck in the mud.
- We recognize that we are stuck, we verbalize that we are stuck, and we accept the fact that we are stuck.
- Don't allow yourself to live stuck in the mud.
- If you are in too deep to get out, use the winch of God's Word and pull yourself right out of the mud and back onto the road to continue your journey.

LOOK FOR THE SPLASH

- Mark 11:23 says for you to tell your mountain to be cast into the sea.
- For some reason we tend to just stop, stare, and talk about how big our mountain is in our life.
- Stop talking to God about your mountain and start talking to your mountain about your God!
- Notice Jesus didn't say push or place your mountain in the sea.
- You need to get your mountain and CAST it into the sea.
- After you have done everything Mark 11:23 tells you to do...get ready for the splash.
- You have to have such a confidence that what you said will work that you are anxiously looking at the ocean for the splashes that come from your mountain being removed.
- What do you say we make some splashes this year!
