

## **DOES YOUR SEED HAVE A PURPOSE?**

### **2 Corinthians 9:6-8 (KJV)**

**6** *But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully.*

**7** *Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.*

*(Message: God loves it when the giver delights in the giving.)*

**8** *And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work:*

- Before you sow a seed you first need to know why you are sowing it.
- Farmers do not aimlessly plant seeds without a purpose.
- Once you have a purpose, v.6 tells you which amount to sow in order to determine your harvest.
- After you have determined the amount, v.7 tells you how to act when you sow.
- v.8 talks about the ability of God.
- He is able to do what He said He would do in v.8, but it's according to us doing verse 6&7 correctly.

## **SET YOUR AFFECTION**

### **1 Chronicles 29:3 (KJV)**

*Moreover, because I have set my affection to the house of my God, I have of mine own proper good, of gold and silver, which I have given to the house of my God, over and above all that I have prepared for the holy house.*

- David set his affection before he gave.
- Notice that David said "because" he set his affection on the house of God, he had more than enough for himself.
- David's offering had a purpose. Its purpose was to build the house of God.
- You should always set you affection towards God's house.

## THE PURPOSE DRIVEN SEED

### **John 3:16 (KJV)**

*For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.*

- God so loved us that He gave.
- He set His affection on us.
- Love will drive you to give.
- The seed He sown was driven by a purpose.
- God's purpose was to redeem His children back to Himself.
- That one seed that God sowed has been producing a harvest for thousands of years.
- That harvest is you (souls).
- Do you have a purpose today?
- What is it that you are believing God for?
- When you give, have a purpose.
- Giving is not always tied to finances, but it is always tied to sacrifice.
- When you sow into the soil that God is sowing into, get ready for a harvest.
- God knows how to plant.
